

Metered Market Close-Up: St. Louis, MO (DMA Rank #21)

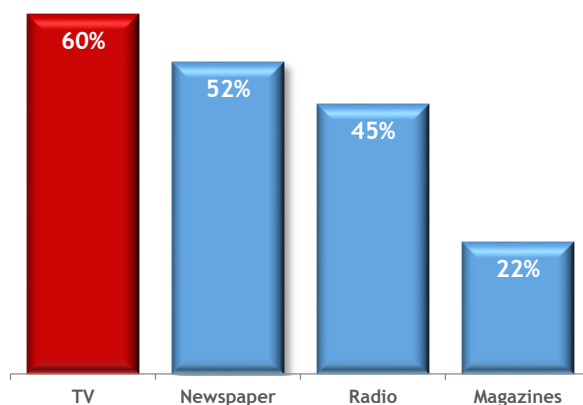
The economy of St. Louis relies on service, manufacturing, trade, transportation of goods, and tourism. The city is home to several major corporations, including Anheuser-Busch, Express Scripts, Peabody Energy, Ameren, Ralcorp, Monsanto, and Sigma-Aldrich, as well as a large medical and research community. St. Louis is a center of medicine and biotechnology. The Washington University School of Medicine is affiliated with Barnes-Jewish Hospital, the fifth-largest hospital in the world. Both institutions operate the Alvin J. Siteman Cancer Center. The School of Medicine also is affiliated with St. Louis Children's Hospital, one of the country's top pediatric hospitals. Boeing employs nearly 15,000 people in its north St. Louis campus, headquarters to its defense unit. Other notable corporations headquartered in the region include Arch Coal, Scottrade, Wells Fargo Advisors, Energizer Holdings, & Patriot Coal. The St. Louis area has a very strong base of cultural and entertainment amenities for a city its size. Other advantages include a highly educated population for a large city and popular professional sports teams- MLB Cardinals and NHL Blues.

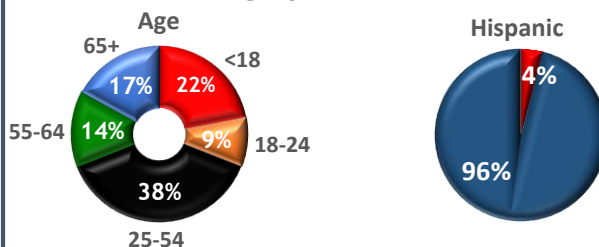
Reliance on Media to Stay Informed % Agree

St. Louis, MO Demographic Overview



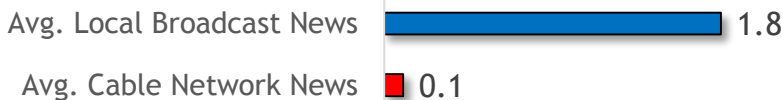
